

The Pompilidae (Hymenoptera: Aculeata) fauna of Turkey: Part II. Pompilinae

Abstract: Records of 154 species and subspecies in 28 genera of the subfamily Pompilinae have been collected by the authors since 1966 throughout almost the whole of Turkey. This review also includes museum material and literature records. 6 genera and 66 species and subspecies are new for the Pompilidae fauna of Turkey. New distribution records are given for many species and subspecies.

Kurzfassung: Seit 1966 wurden von den Autoren in fast allen Teilen der Türkei Nachweise von 154 Arten und Unterarten aus 28 Gattungen von Wegwespen (Pompilidae) der Unterfamilie der Pompilinae gesammelt. Der Überblick schliesst auch Museumsmaterial und Literaturnachweise ein. 6 Gattungen und 66 Arten und Unterarten sind neu für die Pompilidenfauna der Türkei. Für viele Arten und Unterarten werden neue Verbreitungssangaben mitgeteilt.

The first part of the Pompilidae fauna of Turkey covered the subfamilies Ceropalinae and Pepsinae (ÖZBEK et al. 1999). The second part includes the subfamily Pompilinae. Abbreviations for private and museum collections and other details including the literature references were given in the first part. Additional abbreviation: BKAE = Bahçe Kültürleri Araştırma Enstitüsü.

Aporus bicolor Spinola, 1808 (*bicolor* van der Linden, 1827 = *Evagetes not Aporus*)
