1. Proof-reading

We will send you an edited version of your manuscript for proof-reading usually by email. According to our experience, it may happen that some formatting and special characters (such as the symbols for males and females, etc.) may get lost during the transmission process. Please inform us if you need a hard copy (paper version) of your paper for proof-reading.

2. Exclusivity

The author guarantees that the contribution is original, has not been published previously, is not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and that any necessary permission to quote from another source has been obtained.

3. Consent to publish

The author ensures that the publisher has the author's permission to publish the relevant manuscript. With the publication of the paper in *Zoology in the Middle East*, the copyright is formally transferred to the publisher Kasperek Verlag.

4. Linguistic revision

The editors retain the right to make linguistic improvements of the manuscript. Non-native speakers are urgently advised to consult English native-speakers prior to submitting their manuscripts for publication. All manuscripts are checked by a linguistic editor before publication. This takes place after proof-reading by the authors, and it is normally not possible to send the proofs to the authors again at that stage!

5. Off-prints

Twenty-five (25) reprints of each article will be sent to the corresponding author at cost level. The prices are given in the attachment. Please indicate below if you are, for any reasons, not in a position to cover these costs:

- I have taken note of the costs of compulsory reprints.
- I am student and would like to ask for getting the reprints of my article free of charge.

6. Extremely long manuscripts

Pages charges are usually levied on extremely long manuscripts. Current prices are given in the attachment. For further information, please contact the publisher.

7. Subscription information

We wish to invite all authors who do not regularly obtain *Zoology in the Middle East* to subscribe to the journal. Please indicate whether you are

- already a subscriber to *Zoology in the Middle East*, or whether you
- wish to have subscription information and a free sample copy of a back issue.

8. Co-authorship

The author declares that any person named as co-author of the contribution is aware of the fact and has agreed to being named so. All correspondence between the publisher and the author will be made through the corresponding author also on behalf of the co-authors.

Zoology in the Middle East: Information sheet

Publication in *Zoology in the Middle East* is free, but those authors which have not subscribed to the journal have to pay for the compulsory reprints. Pages charges are levied on exceedingly long manuscripts only. All authors of full papers receive thirty reprints at the prices indicated below. Students are not charged for reprints, provided that they indicate their student status on the consent-to-publish form (this is not valid for papers with more than one author).

1. Reprint costs

According to the information given in the consent-to-publish form, the costs of reprints are as follows. Prices for extra reprints on request.

2. Page charges for exceedingly long manuscripts
