1. Exclusivity

The author guarantees that the contribution is original, has not been published previously, is not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and that any necessary permission to quote from another source has been obtained.

2. Co-authorship

The author declares that any person named as co-author of the contribution is aware of this fact and has agreed to being named so. All correspondence between the publisher and the author will be made through the corresponding author also on behalf of the co-authors.

3. Consent to publish

The author ensures that the publisher has the author's permission to publish the relevant manuscript. With the publication of the paper in *Zoology in the Middle East*, the copyright (including the copyright for figures and photographs) is formally transferred to the publisher Kasperek Verlag.

4. Proof-reading

The corresponding author will receive an edited version of the manuscript for proof-reading by email. Please use the "track changes" option of MS WORD for correcting the proofs. Alternatively you can highlight amendments to the manuscript in colour.

5. Linguistic revision

Non-native speakers are urgently advised to consult English native-speakers prior to submitting their manuscripts for publication. The editors retain the right to make linguistic improvements of the manuscript; all manuscripts are checked by a linguistic editor before publication. As this takes place after proof-reading by the authors, it is normally not possible to send the proofs to the authors again at that stage!

6. Off-prints

Twenty (20) compulsory reprints of each article will be sent to the corresponding author at cost level. The prices are given in the attachment. The costs of reprints are waived for students (if single author of a paper) and subscribers to the journal. Please indicate if you ask for waiving the costs for reprints (please tick the appropriate box):

- Student (only single-author papers)
- Subscriber to *Zoology in the Middle East*

7. PDF Files

Producing and disseminating PDF files of articles published in *Zoology in the Middle East* would have a direct negative effect on the sales of the journal, and would thus undermine the financial basis of the journal. The author declares that he/she will not produce and/or disseminate PDF files of his/her article.

8. Long manuscripts

Zoology in the Middle East: Information sheet

(valid from volume 55 ▪ 2012)

Publication in *Zoology in the Middle East* is free in principal, but fees are levied (1) on the compulsory reprints, (2) on exceedingly long manuscripts, and (3) for PDF files/open access (optional).

1. Reprints

According to the information given in the consent-to-publish form, the costs of reprints are as follows.

Students as authors of single-author papers are not charged for reprints, provided that they indicate their student status on the consent-to-publish form (i.e. this is not valid for papers with more than one author).

2. Page charges for exceedingly long manuscripts

number of printed pages	Charges
up to 12 pages	free
over 12 pages	EUR 40.00 per page for institutions

Page charges for long papers may be reduced upon request for authors who do not have access to research funds.

3. PDF Policy and Open Access Fees

As the dissemination of PDF files of articles published in *Zoology in the Middle East* would have a direct negative effect on the sales of the journal and would undermine the financial basis of the journal, the publisher prohibits the free production and dissemination of PDF files.

Authors may purchase PDF files of their articles at a price of EURO 120 per article (irrespective its length). Authors who have purchased PDF files are free to disseminate them also through the internet (e.g. on their own web sites). Open access papers are read by more people and are expected to have higher citation rates.

PDF files can only be ordered in addition to the compulsory reprints.

3. Grants

Individuals who lack the necessary funds for covering the costs for reprints and/or page charges are advised to contact the publisher at the time of manuscript submission.
